University & Whist Club Affinity Offer

As was announced at the January Dinner Meeting, the University & Whist Club has adopted an affinity program of which the Committee of 100 is a part. Any member of the Committee of 100 is entitled to make use of the banquet/catering facilities of the U&W Club without being charged a room fee as is standard for non-member usage of the Club. The Committee of 100 member will need to comply with all other standard rules and practices with regard to non-member usage of the Club, which may include a required deposit for the event.

In addition to use of the banquet/catering facilities of the Club, the organizer of the event or a principal of the Committee of 100 member company may use the dining facilities of the Club on the day of the scheduled event without becoming a member of the Club. For example, if the event is a lunch, then the organizer or the principal may enjoy dinner at the Club that evening. This usage would need to be paid in full at the end of the meal by credit card. This use of this program is limited to only two times each year.
