



2021 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Goal

The goal of the Scholarship program is to support The Committee of 100's mission of promoting responsible economic development by assisting the next generation of business leaders as they prepare to provide the jobs of the future through the study of business, economics, science, technology, engineering, math, or related fields.

Scholarship Recipient Criteria

1. Must be a high school senior living in New Castle County.
2. Must be accepted for admission to an accredited college or university.
3. Must have declared an intention of majoring in business, economics, or a STEM (science, technology, engineering, or math) field.
4. Must demonstrate academic excellence and well-rounded involvement in extra-curricular and community activities.

Application Process

1. Completed applications and all supporting materials must be received at The Committee of 100 offices **no later than 5:00 p.m. on Friday, April 16, 2021. No late applications will be considered.** The preferred application method is electronically via email. However, hard copy applications will be accepted. Email attachments must be in either Microsoft Word or Adobe PDF format.

2. The Committee of 100 Scholarship Committee will select, from among qualified applicants, finalists for interviews, which will be held in late April or early May.
3. The Scholarship will be awarded at The Committee of 100's monthly event, on **Tuesday, May 18, 2021 at 5:30 p.m. Scholarship applicants should reserve that date.**

Scholarship Amount and Payment

The Committee of 100 Academic Scholarship for the academic year 2021-2022 is three-thousand dollars (**\$3,000**) for tuition/room/board expenses. The payment will be made to the Scholarship winner following documentation of enrollment.

The Committee of 100 may offer additional scholarships based upon need, special circumstances, unique accomplishments, and/or a compelling story.

In a separate essay of up to 500 words, write about your academic and vocational goals and describe any challenges or hardships you have overcome. Explain why you should be considered for The Committee of 100 Scholarship. Be sure to attach the essay to this Application.
