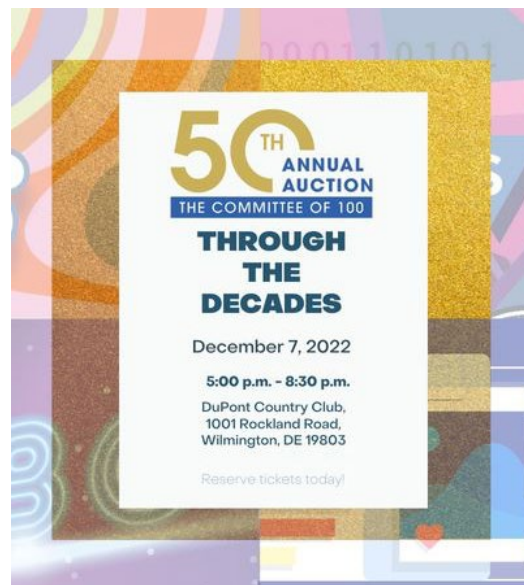

Legislative Update

New Castle County Council:

- **Passed by Council** – Substitute 1 to Ordinance 22-091 – To amend New Castle County Code Chapter 6 (“Building Code”), Article 10 (“Energy Conservation Code”) relating to new commercial construction and the future installation of rooftop solar power
 - As a summary, this Ordinance will require any building 50,000 square feet or more to be built with basic infrastructure to allow a rooftop solar photovoltaic system to be easily and cost-effectively installed at a future date, effective January 1, 2023. - The Committee of 100, ACEC and New Castle County Chamber made a joint statement to oppose the effective date. The council members felt that the process of requesting a modification was acceptable and passed the Ordinance.
 - We will be working with the Land Use Department to obtain and distribute detailed information to our members on the modification process and anything else specific during the implementation of this Ordinance
- Ordinance 22-101
 - Amending New Castle County Code Chapter 40 (“Unified Development Code”, Article 5 (“Site Capacity and Concurrency Calculations”) and Article 10 (“Environmental Standards) relating to critical natural areas
 - We are continuing discussions with the lead Council member on the ordinance regarding the exact locations of the areas. To view the Ordinance, please [click here](#).
- Ordinance 22-112
 - Amending New Castle County Code Chapter 40 (“Unified Development Code”) to establish a protected open space zoning district
